## Reading

We will continue our unit Tackling Longer Words and Longer Books. In this unit students will be discussing story elements, re-reading to improve understanding, identifying problem/solution, & retelling stories with details.

## Math

In math, students will continue Topic 7. In this unit, students will extend their knowledge of addition and subtraction using models, drawings, & equations. Students will continue to practice solving word problems with a symbol for the unknown number in all positions. In addition, we will build our skills by explaining our mathematical thinking in writing.

## Writing

We will continue our unit, Writing About Reading. We will continue to write our opinions about a variety of activities. Students will state clear opinions, reasons, examples, and end with a conclusion statement. We will continue to increase what tools we use as we write including our SNAP word books.



## Social Studies

We will begin our Geography unit by thinking about how the movement of goods & ideas influence the growth of a community. We will also look at how transportation & communication links goods and people both near & far. We will explore cultures and identify how they are different.
